made this 30th day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and nineteen Littleberry Jones of Southampton County and Purcell Bryant of former George county and Purcell Parrot of Southampton County witnesses whereas the said Littleberry Jones for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred Dollars to him in hand paid by the said Purcell Parrot at or before the sealing of this indenture the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Littleberry Jones to the said said best guaranteed bargains and sole and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell and conform unto the said Purcell Parrot two feather beds and furniture two Tables two chests and Loom with all the house hold and kitchen furniture two cows and pigs and two cows and one calf to the said Purcell Parrot his heirs and assigns forever upon trust that whereas at any time when the said Bryant shall for his money the said Purcell Parrot after giving ten days notice proceed and sell the above named property and pay the hundred dollars and all the contingent charges then pay the balance if any to the said Littleberry Jones or his heirs In witness whereof we the said Littleberry Jones and Purcell Parrot, ^{have} set our hands and affixed our seals the day and Year first above written Signed Sealed and delivered in presence of —
