of Southampton County and State of Virginia of the one part and
Richard Blunt and Sarrile Turner of the aforesaid County and State
of the second part and Samuel Turner of the said County and State
of the third part. Witnesseth that whereas the said Turner-Nelson
is justly indebted to the Collin W Barnes Executor of Sarrile
Barnes decd in the sum of nine hundred dollars by a writing
obligatory on demand the second day of February eighteen hun-
dred and twenty one the said Richard Blunt and Sarrile Turner
is security for the said Turner-Nelson to Collin W Barnes
Executor as aforesaid for the payment of the above sum of
money and the said Turner-Nelson being willing and
disposed to secure the said Richard Blunt and Sarrile Turner
for becoming his security for the above sum of money and
all cost for carrying into effect these presents. Now this
indenture witnesseth that the said Turner-Nelson for and
in consideration of the sum of One dollar to him in hand paid
by the said Samuel Turner the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained sold and by these presents
