WHEREAS Thomas R Collier and Lucy Ann his wife by their due bearing
 date the 26th day of March 1820 hath conveyed to Edward Butts four lots
 in the town of Monroe and County of Southampton Number 16, 17, 34 & 39
 in trust for the purpose of securing harmless Elizabeth Mc Collier who
 was bound as security for the said Thomas R Collier in a bond taken
 for the forth coming of property taken upon the service of writ of capias
 and satisfaction thereof issued from the County Court of Southampton in
 favour of Emma Turner and the said Edward Butts at the request of the
 said Elizabeth Mc Collier having sold the same at publick auction more there
 for this indenture made this 15th day of May 1820 between the said
 Edward Butts of the one part and Thomas W Heath of the other
 Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of forty five dollars
 to the said Edward Butts in hand paid by the said Thomas W Heath
 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged the said Edward Butts hath
 granted bargained and sold and do hereby grant bargain sell alien enfeoff
 and confirm unto the said Thomas W Heath his heirs and assigns forever
 four lots of land lying and being in the town of Monroe and County
 of Southampton known and distinguished by the plan of said town
 by N 16, 17, 34 & 39 containing one half acre each and bounded as
 described in the deed from Clements Rochelle and Wife to Thomas R
 Collier which is of record in the County Court of Southampton reference
 being had thereto the same will more fully appear To Have and to Hold
 the above mentioned lots or parcel of land to him the said Thomas W
 Heath his heirs and assigns forever and the said Edward Butts for
 himself his heirs executors and administrators do by these presents warrant and
 defend the right and title of the said lots or parcel of land to the said
 Thomas W Heath his heirs or assigns against them the said Edward
 Butts his heirs and assigns in Testimony whereof I have hereunto set
 my hand and affixed my seal the day and year first written
 signed sealed and acknowledged
