her separately And apart from her husband Whether she freely
willingly gave of her own accord without the persuasion or
threats of her husband executed the within deed And whether she
is willing this present Indenture should be recorded in the
County Court of Southampton To all of which she consented

at a court held for the County aforesaid on the 17th day
