 at a small red oak a c. of Lemuel Stanton standing not far from
 the edge of a small Branch thence S 80 W 13 poles to another small
 red oak a c. of the said Lemuel Stanton thence S 26 E 59 poles
 a post or mark in the meeting House land and in Samuels
 line on the side of the road leading from Black Creek bridge
 to Jerusalem thence along the said road making it the true
 boundary line of the meeting House land and the said James Jones say
 N 50 E or nearly 13 poles to a small red oak a c. on a corner of
 Jones' land and on the side of the same road thence N 26 W
