tract and adjoining the said crop Bay tract also the Lane and plant
-ten known by the name of Driskis land and is also adjoining the crop
Bay and an other small tract or parcel of land purchase of
James Gray and adjoining the tract lot of Mrs Sally Everett
called Driskis land as aforesaid which said several tracts or
parcel of lands have been recently procured & the lines and
