Benjamin Cobb and Susanna his wife of the County of Southampton  
of the one part and Henry Scott of the County of Sussex of the  
other part Witnesseth that the said Benjamin Cobb & Susanna  
his wife for and in consideration of the sum of three thousand dollars  
Lawful money of Virginia to them in hand paid have given  
granted bargained and sold & by these presents do give grant  
bargain & sell unto the said Henry Scott and his heirs all the  
tract and parcel of land lying and being in the County of  
St. Ampton Containing by estimation three Hundred Acres be the  
same more or less and bounded as follows (Viz) by the lands of  
William Bell Samuel Drury and the orphans of Joseph Drury  
dec'd which said plantation tract or parcel of land was purchased  
by Benjamin Cobb of John Bruchlor dec'd do have and to  
hold the said tract of land together with the appurtenances to him  
the said Henry Scott and his heirs and the said Benjamin Cobb  
and Susanna his wife their and each of their heirs Executors and  
admsrs the said tract or parcel of land with the appurtenances to  
him the said Henry Scott his heirs and assigns shall well & lawfully
