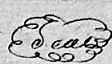


Southampton County to Wit

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We Silas Summels and John L. Gray Justices of the peace in the County aforesaid in the State of Virginia do hereby Certify that Amelia Clayton the wife of James Clayton and Peggy Washington wife of Anasew Washington parties to a certain Deed for the conveyance of real Estate to Phadrock Bayless bearing date on the 25th day November 1819 and hereto annexed personally appeared before us in our County aforesaid and being Examined by us privately and apart from their said Husband and having the Deed aforesaid fully explained to them they the said Amelia Clayton and Peggy Washington acknowledged the same to be their act and deed and declared that they had willingly signed sealed and delivered the same and that they wished not to retract it Given under our hands and seals this 25th day of November 1819

This indenture was proved by the oath of John L. Gray and William Snyder two of the Justices hereto as to Joseph Washington Anasew Washington James Clayton and Carr Bonners parties and together with a certificate for the giving examination and acknowledgments of Peggy Washington and Amelia Clayton returned and continued for further proof. And in the clerk's office the 2nd day of September 1820 This indenture was further proved by the oath of Silas Summels another Justice hereto as to Joseph Washington Anasew Washington James Clayton and Carr Bonners and together with the certificate aforesaid were admitted to record. And at a Court held for the County of Southampton on the 18th of September 1820 This indenture and certificate as aforesaid was entered upon the proceedings of the day
