This Indenture made this thirteenth day of October
One thousand eight hundred and Nineteen between Francis Ridley
Executor of Joseph Masters decd of the one part and Edwin Putney
of the other part Witnesseth that the said Francis Ridley for and in con-
sideration of the sum of One thousand and twenty one dollars to him in
hand paid at or before sealing and delivery of these presents the
receipt whereof the said Francis Ridley do hereby acknowledge and
himself fully paid have granted bargained and sold Alien and
aff released and confirmed and by these presents do grant bargain
sell alien release and confirm unto the said Edwin
Putney his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of
land situate lying and being in the County of Southampton and bound
as follows Beginning at the head of Grey Neck mill
pond in Admthw Parkers line thence down the run of
the Swamp to Thomas Ridleys line thence along his
