the 1st day of February in the year eighteen hundred and twenty between
Edward Lundy of the first part and John Gray of the second part
and Arthur Williamson of the third part whereas the said Arthur
Williamson has become security or bail for the said Edward Lundy
Lundy in three certain cases James Harris V.S. said Lundy for the sum of
one hundred and twenty four dollars and interest and cost and James
Harris assignee of J. Walker for one hundred and ten dollars interest
and cost also John Parham for twenty four dollars interest and cost
also the said Williamson is by the said Lundy requested to take up any
debts or debts due from him and the said Edward Lundy being desirous
to secure and indemnify the said Arthur Williamson from all damages
and losses which he the said Williamson may sustain from his be-
coming bail for the said Lundy or by the said Lundy failing to
pay any debt or debts due ^{from} him which the said Williamson may have
to answer by them the said Lundy failing to pay on or before the first
day of October next next this indenture witnesseth that the said Edward
Lundy for and in consideration of these presents and the sum of one dollar
to him paid by the said John ^{Gray} to the said Edward Lundy hath granted bargained
and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto
the said John Gray by him and assigns forever the following property to wit
One certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of ^{Southampton} ~~York~~
and bounded by the lands of James Harris and Susan ^{Gray} Lundy
orphan of James Lundy decd and the orphan of Richard Malby
decd and also by the lands of the orphan of William Heyrick deceased
containing by late survey three hundred and sixty three acres in the
same more or less also the following negroes to wit Looke Cherry Winny
Mallie Isabel Mary Tom Ann & c. together with the household
and kitchen furniture and plantation utensils &c. thereto belonging
to have and to hold the same unto the said John Gray his heirs and
assigns forever upon trust nevertheless in case any judgment or
judgments recovery or recoveries should be attained or had against
the said Edward Lundy by the said Arthur Williamson becoming
unpaid the first day of October next then and in that case
the said John Gray shall and may at any time after giving
