

October one thousand eight hundred and twenty Solomon Solomon High and Emely his wife of the one part and William Agasquet of the other part all of the Town of Petersburg Virginia do hereby certify that the said Solomon High and Emely his wife hath for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars to them in hand paid the receipt of which they do hereby acknowledge have granted bargained and sold Agasquet and to his heirs and assigns forever one certain lot of ground situated in the town of merrim in the county of Saint James Parish in the plan of said town by number twenty four containing one acre and bounded as follows to wit on the south by Washington Street on the west by Catherin Street on the north by Madison Street and on the east by Williams Ricks and Lotments Peckley lots To Have and to hold the said lot of land with all and singular the advantages and emoluments hereafter arriving unto him the said William Agasquet and to his heirs and assigns forever And the said Solomon High and Emely his wife each do hereby respectively warrant and defend each of their respective interest in the said Lot of Land unto him the said William Agasquet and to his heirs and assigns forever against the claim of them or either of them their heirs executors administrators or any other person whatsoever In witness whereof the parties to this deed have hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals the day and date first herein written
