This Indenture

made this twentieth day of July in the year of Our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty between Charlotte Harris widow and relict of James Harris dec'd said of Southampton County Virginia of the one part and Joseph William Thomas & William Thomas Harwell and Edith Harris of the second part, Witnesseth that the said Charlotte Harris for and in consideration of the sum of seventeen hundred dollars to her in hand paid by the said William Thomas and Harwell and Harris at and before stating and delivery of this presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath given granted released and confirmed and by these presents doth give grant release confirm and power quit claim unto the said Joseph William Thomas & William Thomas Harwell and Edith Harris all and every species of interest title or right what soever by her possessed or enjoyed or by her so her possessed or enjoyed in the estate both real and personal of her late husband James Harris and also the said Charlotte Harris for herself her heirs and assigns doth hereby command warrant and agree to and with the said William Thomas Harwell and Harris that she will renounce all benefit and advantage accruing to her under the will of her said late husband and that she hereby relinquish all right and title by and under the same Reserving unto herself however all the property belonging to her prior to the intermarriage of the said Charlotte Harris and her late husband to wit the negro slaves Polly Harriet Henry Albert and Stanley all bonds and acc'ts which were due to her prior to the said marriage and all other property of every species and description which in like manner was possessed by her and the said William Thomas Harwell and Harris doth hereby warrant and secure all title to the said property last above described unto the said Charlotte Harris her heirs and assigns against the claim or claims of themselves their heirs and assigns and all other persons claiming or to claim under them now and forever by testimony whereof the parties have hereunto set their hands and seals the day and year first herein written
