This Indenture made this 7th day of January in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand eight hundred and twenty Between Nathaniel Britt and Polly Britt his wife both of the county of Southampton and Parish of Saint Peter of the one part and Alexander David for of the same county and a parish of the other part Witnesseth that the said Nathaniel Britt and Polly his wife for and in consideration of the sum of one thousand Dollars and twenty eight Dollars and current money of Virginia to them in hand paid by the said Alexander David for the receipt whereof the said Nathaniel Britt and Polly his wife doth acknowledge themselves fully and amply satisfied and paid hath granted bargained sold aliened conveyed and confirmed and by these presents hath granted bargained sold and conveyed and confirmed unto the said Alexander David for one certain tract or parcel of land and premises situate lying and being in the county and parish aforesaid containing by
