Know all men by these presents That I Thomas Vaughan  
of the county of Southampton for and in consideration of natural love  
affection and of the sum of one hundred dollars to me in  
hand paid by Mary Thomas Vaughan decendant of the county aforesaid  
at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents. Do witness  
wherop I do hereby acknowledge have bargained sold granted and  
conformed and by these presents do bargain sell grant and conform to  
the said Mary Thomas Vaughan a certain female negro slave named  
Betty to have and to hold the said female negro slave named Betty  
and her future increase to the only proper now and lato of the said  
Mary Thomas Vaughan and her heirs forever and I the said Thomas  
Vaughan for myself my heirs executors the said negro female  
slave with her increase to the said Mary Thomas Vaughan  
and her heirs against me the said Thomas Vaughan and my heirs  
and against all and every person and persons whatsoever claiming  
by through or under the said Thomas Vaughan shall and will  
marry and forever defend by these presents In witness whereof  
I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this thirteenth  
day of May in the year of our eighteen hundred and twenty
