(His) Indenture

Westbrook made this 29th day of May in the year of our Lord and thousand eighteen
Examine and witness between Francis Cotton of the County of Southampton
of the one part and Henry J. Westbrook of the County aforesaid of the
other part witnesseth that the said Francis Cotton for and consideration
of the sum of Sixty two dollars and fifty cents good and current money
of Virginia to the in hand paid by the said Henry J. Westbrook
the receipt whereof the said Francis Cotton doth hereby acknowledge himself
fully and surely satisfied and saith hath granted bargained sold and
unpaid and confirmed unto by these presents as the grand bargain
and sale unto the said Henry J. Westbrook a certain tract of land
of land laid off in the west of the said tract wherein the said
Francis Cotton now resides by a late Survey delineated lying and being
in the County of aforesaid containing Eighty acres and a half to the
same more or less and bounded as follows to wit beginning at a
pine in Henry J. Westbrook line running thence N 10 W 25 p
poles a new line to a pine thence N 24 W 16 poles to a pine in
said Cottons and Henry Applegate line thence S b 3 M 79 of
poles to a red oak at corner of said Cotton and Applegate and
Westbrook thence E 77 East 51 poles to a pine on said Westbrook
line thence S b 3 E 29 for poles to the beginning together with all the
houses out houses outhouses buildings yards gardens orchard, may
water and water courses whatever belonging or in any wise appurte-
ning to the said tract or parcel of land and premises aforesaid
to have and to hold the said tract to him and his heirs forever and the
said Francis Cotton doth for herself her heirs and assigns covenant
and agrees to and with the said Henry J. Westbrook his heirs
or assigns that they will by these presents warrant and for ever
defend all right title claim or demand of any person or persons
claiming or demanding the same or any part or parcel thereof

her hand and seal the day and year first above written
