 This Indenture made this 29th day of May in the year of 17. war Ford and there
 of eight hundred and thirty between Charlotte Westbrooke free Mulatto of the County
 of Southampton of the one part and Henry John Person Westbrooke of the County of
 of the other part doth certify that the said Charlotte Westbrooke free Mulatto
 for and consideration of the sum of twenty eight Dollars and eighty Cents
 paid and lawfull money of Virginia to her in hand paid by the said Henry
 J. Westbrooke the receipt whereof the said Charlotte Westbrooke free Mulatto
 doth hereby acknowledge herself fully and amply satisfied and has with
 granting bargained sold deemed sufficient and confirmed and by these presents
 doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Henry J. Westbrooke
 a certain part or parcel of land laid off on the N.E. of the tract
 whereon the said Charlotte Westbrooke free Mulatto now lives by a
 late survey situate lying and being in the county aforesaid containing
 four acres and eight tenths be the same more or less and bounded
 as follows Beginning at a Sassafras Bush in Thomas Little's line running
 thence N. 28° East 18 1/2 poles to a corner in Thomas Little's line N. 57°
 East 42 1/2 poles to a corner in the said line thence S. 26° N. 18 1/2 poles
 along said Henry J. Westbrooke's line to a Postumum tree thence
 S. 57° E. 42 poles to new line to the beginning together with all the
 houses out houses gardens buildings yards gardens orchards ways water
 and water courses whatsoever to belonging or in anywise appertaining to the
 said free or parcel of land and premises aforesaid To Have and to Hold
 the same to him and his heirs heirs forever and the said Charlotte Westbrooke
 free Mulatto doth for herself her heirs Executors and assigns covenant and
 agree to and with the said Henry J. Westbrooke his heirs and assigns that
 they will by these presents make out and forever defend all right title
 claim or demand of any person or persons claiming or demanding the same or any
 part or parts thereof In witness whereof the said Charlotte Westbrooke free Mulatto
 hath hereunto set her hand and seal the day and year first above written Signed
