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This Indenture made this 2nd day of September 1820
 Between James A. Parham and Louisa his wife Theophilus Jagers
 and James his wife all of the county of Southampton and State of
 Virginia of the one part Lewis Morrell of the said county and State
 of the other part Witnesseth that the said James A. Parham
 and Louisa his wife Theophilus Jagers and James his wife for and
 consideration of the sum of Sixty Dollars to them in hand paid
 by the said Lewis Morrell the receipt being hereby acknowledged
 have bargained sold aliened enfeoffed and confirmed and by these presents
 doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Lewis Morrell his heirs &
 assigns forever All our interest title claim and demand of in and to
 our undivided part or portion of the lands of Nathaniel Parham
 at Spring the land and plantation that was allotted to Nancy Parham
 wife of the said Nathaniel Parham dead as her dower right
 in said Land do Have and to Have the said undivided part or
 portion of Land of the said Nathaniel Parham dead as was allotted
 to the said Nancy Parham wife of the said Nathaniel Parham dead
 as her dower lands to him the said Lewis Morrell his heirs forever
 together with all right title interest claim or demand
 of in and to the said our undivided part or portion of the said lands
 of Nathaniel Parham dead as was allotted to the said Nancy
 Parham wife of the said dead as her dower right Land and the
 said James Parham Louisa his wife Theophilus Jagers and
 James his wife do for themselves their heirs Executors assigns
 marshall and forever defend the title of the said undivided part or
 portion of Land unto him the said Lewis Morrell clear and
 against the lawful claims of all persons whatsoever but
 witness whereof the said James A. Parham Louisa his wife
 Theophilus Jagers and James his wife have hereunto set their
 hands and affixed their seals the day and year first above
