Basquet of the other part all of the town of Petersburg Virginia ^{that the said Solomon} High and Emily his wife both for and in consideration of the sum of one thousand dollars to them in hand paid the receipt of which they do hereby acknowledge have granted bargained and sold and by these presents both grant bargain and sell unto the said William A. Basquet and to his heirs and assigns forever one certain lot of ground situated in the town of Abnash on Potomac River in the county of Southampton and known and designated in the map or plat of said town as Lot No. 1 and bounded on Jackson Street from the river to the junction of Madison Street ^{thence up Madison Street} thirty five yards to a corner stone from thence to the river at the water edge at post from thence down the river on the edge of the water to the beginning supposed to contain half an acre or the same more or less To Have and to hold the said lot of land with all and singular the advantages and emoluments hereafter arising unto him the said William A. Basquet and to his heirs and assigns forever and the said Solomon High and Emily his wife each doth hereafter respectively warrant and defend each of their respective interest in the said lot of land unto him the said William A. Basquet and to his heirs and assigns
