year of our Lord Christ one thousand eight hundred and twenty
between Edward W. Sones of the county of Southampton
parish of St. Luke of the one part and Anselm of the
county and parish aforesaid of the second part and
James Ellis of the said county and parish of St. Mary
as trustee of the third part. Witnesseth that the said
Edward W. Sones in order to secure the following debts
into the said Anselm Sones to the amount of fifty four
dollars 52¹/₂ cents and its interest until paid by the
presentors bargain sold set over and confirm and by their
presentors hath granted bargained and sold unto the said
James Ellis as trustee for the said Anselm Sones to him and
his heirs forever one feather bed and furniture one small
ditch and furniture two trunks one pine chest one set
of cups and Saccary one set of earthen plates two
dishes one set of knives and forks one frying pan
one pot one shoemakers tools and some
more
