thereof with every of their rights members and appurtenances unto  
the said Henry P. Vaughan his heirs and assigns forever (to and  
for the only proper use and behoof of him the said Henry P.  
Vaughan for use and the said Thomas Vaughan for himself  
and his heirs the said plantation and tract of land with all  
and singular the premises and appurtenances before mentioned  
together with all and singular the Slaves and other personal prop-  
erty aforesaid unto the said Henry P. Vaughan his heirs and  
assigns free from the claim or claims of them the said Thomas  
Vaughan and his heirs or either of them and of all and every  
person or persons whatsoever claiming by through or under them  
shall will and doth warrant and forever defend by these presents
