This Indenture made this 10th day of August in the year
eighteen hundred and twenty between John Willeford of Southampton
county and state of Virginia of the one part and Arthur Williamson
of said county of the other part. Witnesseth that the said John
Willeford being fully in debt to Arthur Williamson of said
county in the sum of twenty eight dollar munty .57 c Virginia
money and by bond with lawfull interest from this date and
being willing and desirous to secure the payment of the said
debt to the said Arthur Williamson in consideration whereof
and more over for an inconsideration of the sum of one dollar
in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby fully acknowledged
the said John Willeford hath given granted bargained and
sold and by these presents doth give grant bargain grant
bargain sell and make over unto the said Arthur Williamson
his heirs and assigns forever the following property to wit
one bed and furniture 1 chest and spinning wheel 1 table one
iron pot 1 spider and pan 1 Spoon 5 earthen plates 1 pewter
plates 2 pewter basons 2 tan cutts 1 set knives and forks
3 E. Dishes 1 set cups and saucers one pitcher 1 coffee pot 1 dripping
boil 1 set cords 2 axes 1 Bed and 1 parter 1 P. Box 1 floor
1 Sifter 1 corr. 13 head Hogs 1 iron tea kettle To Have and to
hold the said property unto the said Arthur Williamson
his heirs and assigns forever in trust for said Arthur Williamson
his heirs &c. for the express purpose of paying the said
Arthur Williamson on the sum of twenty eight dollar
and munty five c Virginia money or upon the said John
Willeford should make default therein it is hereby agreed
and declared to be the true intent and meaning of this
indenture that if the said sum as above specified be not
paid unto the said Arthur Williamson with all interest
thereon on or before the 10th day of September next ensuing
the debt hereof then the said Arthur Williamson shall be
at full liberty at any time ^{thereafter} when it may suit him
the said debt or any part thereof still remaining unpaid
to require and compel the said Arthur Williamson to take
into his possession all the property specified in the deed
and after advertising the time and place of sale for at
least ten days at three publick publick places convenient to
the residence of the said John Willeford to sell for ready
money all the said property contained in this deed or so much
as may be sufficient to answer the purpose herein specified
and the said Arthur Williamson shall have full power
and authority to make over in writing a lawfull note
and title to the purchaser or purchasers of said property
