This Indenture made this twenty first day of November
in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty
by and between James Dillard executor of the last will and
testament of Richmond Dillard deceased late of Southampton county
and State of Virginia of the one part and Edwin C. Hark of
the same county and State of the other part Witnesseth that
the said James Dillard executor as aforesaid for and in consideration
of the sum of one thousand seven hundred and fifty one
dollars to him the said James Dillard paid or secured to be
paid before the making and delivery of these premises by the said
James Dillard hath granted sold aliened and confirmed and by
these premises doth grant bargain sell alienate and confirm
unto him the said Edwin C. Hark and to his heirs and assigns
possessory one certain tract or parcel of Land being in the County
of Southampton aforesaid in the former district of New Norfolk
parish comprehending three different Tracts or pieces of Land
purchased by the said Richmond Dillard in his life
time two of them from John Lee that one for one
hundred acres including the mansion House and other out
houses orchard garden &c. which the said Richmond Dillard
at the time of his death the other for fifty one acres the mill
pond and the acre of land purchased from Jordan Williams
for the use of the mill the other he purchased from James Lee
containing sixty four and a half acres and lies in the forty
of the Mill pond the whole making one entire tract contain-
ing by estimation two hundred and fifteen and a half
acres and is bounded as follows that is to say Beginning at a
corner in John Parker's line in the center of the road
where the road crosses a line between John Parker and Edwin
C. Hark's running thence down the various courses of
the swamp and John Parker's line to a cypress a corner
tree standing in or near the run of the swamp between
the mill's thence and easterly corner along a line of marked trees
to James Dardens line thence along Dardens line
to the of the late Isaac A. Holland's land thence along Holland's
line to Peter Moore's line thence along Peter Moore's line to the
center of the Indian Branch where it is crossed by the road
leading from South quay to Mousasco thence along the road
to the first Station together with the remainder remaining
reversions and reversionary rents profits thereof
