 as aforesaid hath granted bargain sold aliened and confirmed and
 by these presents doth grant bargain sell and confirm unto him the

 tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Southampton
 and Parish of St. Andrew containing by estimation one hundred
 and two Acres but the same more or less
