This Indenture made this twenty third day of December in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and twenty between Daniel Knight of the County of Southampton of the one part and Jacob Williams of the said County of the other part Witnesseth that the said Daniel Knight for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred and forty seven Dollars and fifty cents current money of Virginia to him by the said Jacob Williams in hand paid the receipt whereof the said Daniel Knight doth hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained sold & conveyed by these presents doth grant bargain sold and convey to the said Jacob Williams his heirs assigns a certain tract or parcel parcel of Land containing fifty five acres be the same more or less lying and being in the County of Southampton and known by the name of B and bounded as follows (to wit) Beginning at a small red oak a new corner made between Peter D. Knight and Thomas D. Knight and in Nathan Pope's line 70 m. 40 poles to a pine a corner of Nathan Pope near his fence and on the side of a small branch thence N 37 m. 50 poles or Variation on the line thence N 17 m. 50 poles to a small Hickory a new corner made between Daniel Knight and Thomas D. Knight and in John Fitzhugh's Estate and thence N 70 E 30 poles to a small oak a new corner made between Daniel Knight and Thomas D. Knight thence along the
