The Indenture made this 18th day of December one thousand eight hundred and twenty between Owen Myrick of the one part and Nathaniel Rochee of the other part both of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia Witnesseth that the said Owen Myrick and hath for an consideration of the sum of one thousand dollars to him in hand paid by the said Nathaniel Rochee hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain sell unto the said Nathaniel Rochee and to his heirs and assigns forever a certain piece or parcel of land situated and being in the County of Southampton and State of Virginia and adjoining the lands of John Myrick containing two hundred acres be the same more or less Beginning at a place ^{a corner} in John Myrick's and William Peters line thence along the said line north to a stake a corner in William Peters line thence along the said line west to a pine in William Peters line thence along the said line south west to a pine corner in William Peters and the orphans of Benjamin Sealmones line thence along the said line south to a Bay tree a corner in John Myrick's and Lucy Stearns's line thence east to the first Stake to have and to have the said parcel of land unto him the said Nathaniel Rochee and to his heirs and assigns forever against the claim and demand of the said Owen Myrick and his heirs or assigns and against the claim of any other person or persons whatsoever In witness whereof the said Owen Myrick has hereunto set his hand and affixed his Seal the day and date above mentioned Signed and acted and agreed in presence of Edmund d. Day
