Know all men by these presents that I Ann Harris of the
county of Southampton and State of Virginia for and in con-
sideration of the natural love and affection which I bear
to James Adolphus Jones and Elizabeth Ann W Jones
children of Horatio Jones and Elizabeth Jones his wife
of the of Hertford county and State of North Carolina
has well as for the further consideration of one dollar to
me in hand paid at or before the sealing and delivery
of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
have given and granted and by these presents do give and grant
unto the said James A Jones and Elizabeth Ann W Jones
their Executors administrators and assigns four negroes by the
names of Tom Mason Lambidge and Moses Nig. I give
to James Adolphus Jones Tom and Moses and to
Elizabeth Ann W Jones Lambidge and Mason unto
them and their heirs forever after my death and the
said Ann Harris for herself her Executors or
administrators the said Tom Mason Moses Lambidge
into the said James Adolphus Jones and Elizabeth
Ann W Jones their heirs Executors administrators
and assigns against the claims of her the said Ann
Harris her Executors administrators and against the claims
of all and every other persons or persons whatsoever shall
warrant and ever defend them by these presents I witness
whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this
20th day of October. 1819
