Witnesseth that the said Geo. Williams for and in consideration
of the just and full sum of one hundred dollars fifty nine and
a half cents good money of Virginia by the said Joseph Denson
is now in hand paid before the executing and delivery of these presents
the receipt whereof the said Geo. Williams doth hereby acknowledge
and thereof acquit and discharge the said Joseph Denson his heirs
and assigns forever and himself therewith fully and entirely satisfied
consented and gave the said Geo. Williams hath granted bargained
sold aliened enfeoffed released let over delivered and confirmed and
by these presents hath granted bargained sold aliened enfeoffed released let over
delivered and confirmed unto the said Joseph Denson and to his heirs &
assigns forever a part of that messuage tract and parcel of land
that the said Geo. Williams deced. gave to Geo. Williams in
his last will and testament lying in the County of Southampton
and parish aforesaid comprising a part of the lands belonging
or appertaining to the said Geo. Williams containing by estimation
fifty six acres $2\frac{1}{2}$ be the same more or less and bounded by the
known and reputed bounds thereof. To have and to hold the said
plantation messuage tract and parcel of fifty six acres of
land be the same more or less and premises with all and every the
appurtenances unto him the said Joseph Denson and to his heirs
and assigns forever and the said Geo. Williams for himself his
heirs and assigns forever to the only proper use and behoof of
him the said Joseph Denson his heirs and assigns forever
and the said Geo. Williams for himself his heirs and assigns
the said plantation messuage and parcel of fifty six acres
of land be the same more or less and premises with all
and every the appurtenances as aforesaid unto him the said Joseph
Denson and to his heirs and assigns forever against them
the said Geo. Williams and against his heirs executors
Administrators and assigns and against all and every the present
or persons whatsoever claiming or demanding the land or any
part thereof shall and will warrant and forever defend by
these presents and the said Geo. Williams for himself his
heirs and assigns with hereby covenant promise and agree to
pay unto the said Joseph Denson his heirs or assigns
aforesaid sum of one hundred thirty two dollars
fifty
