This Indenture made this 12th day of August in the year one thousand eight hundred and twenty between Jesse P. Drake of the first part Alexander Myrick of the second part and Clements Rochelle William E. Daugherty and James Bishop Comm^{rs} to Sell and divide the estate of Jeremiah Drake of the third part all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia testifies that whereas the said Jesse P. Drake stands justly indebted to the said Clements Rochelle William E. Daugherty and James Bishop Comm^{rs} in the full and true sum of two hundred dollars and thirty five and 3/8 cents and by Note bearing equal date with these presents and the said Jesse P. Drake being willing and desirous to secure unto the said Comm^{rs} the payment of the said debt with interest and cost also for the further consideration of one dollar now hand paid unto the said Jesse P. Drake by the said Alexander Myrick the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained sold and by these presents hath grant bargained and sold unto the said Alexander Myrick all the interest in the said Jesse P. Drake has in the lands Jeremiah Drake his father and seized and proposed of upon this condition to wit that the said Alexander Myrick his Executors administrators shall after giving thirty days notice at the court house door either at the request of the said Jesse P. Drake or the said Clements Rochelle William E. Daugherty or James Bishop Commissioners expose to public sale all the interest Jesse P. Drake has in the lands Jeremiah Drake and seized and proposed of for cash and out of the proceeds of said sale pay over to the aforesaid Clements Rochelle William E. Daugherty and James Bishop Commissioners as aforesaid the sum of two hundred Dollars and thirty five and 3/8 cents interest and cost and the balance if any Pay
