This Indenture made this 26th day of October eighteen
hundred and twenty Drury Drury Drury Esq. of James Drury
deceased of the County of Southampton of the one part and Emma
Drury and Selviah Drury of the other part witnesseth that the
said Drury Drury for and in satisfaction of the sum of fifteen hundred
and eighty five dollars well due and to him her heirs part by the said
Emma Drury and Selviah Drury the receipt is hereby acknowledged
that bargain sold alien free and confirm unto the said Emma
Drury and Selviah Drury and to their heirs forever one certain
tract or parcel of land lying in the County of Southampton
aforesaid and in the parish of St. Lukes containing by estimation one
hundred twenty seven and 7/8 acres more or less and half to Emma
Drury and the other to Selviah Drury and bounded as followeth
(viz) Beginning at a black gum a corner in the Parrot's line
thence along said Parrot's line to a red oak an omiles line thence
along Meles line to a red oak near the side of the Swamp house
Swamp thence with the swamp corner then across the run of said
Swamp to the long branch in Lammes Cocks line then up the run
of said Branch to the beginning all the right tells of in and to
the said land and plantation from the said Drury Drury
to have and to hold the said tract and parcel of land and premises
with its appurtenances unto the said Emma Drury and Selviah
Drury and their heirs forever to the proper use and behoof of him
the said Emma Drury and Selviah Drury and the said Drury
Drury for themselves their heirs &c. with forever warrant and defend
the title of the same and every part thereof against all and every
person and persons whatsoever as witness hereof I have hereunto set
my hand and affix my seal this day and year first above written
