This Indenture made this second of February One thousand eight hundred and twenty One between Henry Melch of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the first part Joseph B. Whithead of the County of Guilford and State of Virginia of the second part and Richard H. Barn of the County of Southampton and State of the third part Witnesseth that whereas the said Henry Melch stands justly indebted to the said Joseph B. Whithead in the past and full sum of nine hundred and twenty seven dollars due by bond bearing date the 1st of August 1819 and on demand the 14th of January 1821 and the said Henry Melch being dissolved the further consideration of one dollar is here in hand paid by the said Richard H. Barn Trustee the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged well granted bargained sold confirmed and conveyed and by these presents with grant bargain sold confirm and convey to Richard H. Barn Trustee his heirs &c. all his right title and interest in law or equity to the following property one double gig and harness eight feather beds and furniture four cows with their increase twenty nine heads of sheep one mahogany dining table one mahogany sideboard table one tea table one mahogany desk and also one a mahogany side board bureau one yoke of oxen and carry log cart and what was contained therein also and all the stock of merchandise or trade he may have on hand now or at any time before July next and the said Henry Melch for himself his heirs executors &c. by these presents doth covenant and agree to and with the said Richard H. Barn Trustee his heirs executors &c. to warrant and defend the title to the aforementioned property against himself his heirs executors &c. and all and every person whatsoever to whom the said Richard H. Barn Trustee his heirs executors &c. upon special trust and confidence and for no other purpose that is to say should the said Henry Melch his heirs executors &c. fail to pay and satisfy the before named bond and interest on or before the first of July next then the said Richard H. Barn Trustee his heirs &c. shall have legal power and authority whomever called on by the said Joseph B. Whithead is and after first giving ten days public notice of the time and place of such sale the before mentioned property and ask of the persons offered said first to pay and satisfy all debt attending such sale then the said Joseph B. Whithead his debt and interest and the surplus if any to the said H. Melch or his legal representatives.
