This Indenture made this 10th day of February in the year of
Our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty one between John Westbrooks
and Amye his wife of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia
of the one part and Wm Francis of the aforesaid County and State
of the other part witnesseth that the said John Westbrooks and Amye
his wife for and consideration of the sum of four hundred and fifty dollars
to the said John Westbrooks in hand paid the receipt whereof
is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained sold and by these presents begone
bargain and sell land containing one acre and a half poles to the said
Wm Francis for one certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of
Southampton and State of Virginia containing eighty three acres to the second
mer or less and bounded as follows beginning at a large Post oak a corner
of Wm Francis and the said land in foursome corners line running thence
North 13 degrees true and a half poles to a red oak a corner of Edmund
Turner and said lands in Wm Francis line thence South 81 miles one hundred
and thirty five poles to a black gum a new corner in Edmund Turner and said
lands thence South 15 West one hundred and thirty six poles to a white oak
a new corner in Wm Francis red and said lands thence N 63 E
one hundred and forty one and a half poles to the Beginning to
Wm Francis
