This Indenture made and entered into this 33rd day of December
in the year 1820 Between Henry Mish of the first part James Atgray
of the second part and Merriweather P. Brannan of the third part all
of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia Witnesseth that the said
Henry Mish for and consideration of the sum of
which sum the said Henry Mish with the said James Atgray as his
security is bound to pay unto John M. Mote merchant in New York by
this bond bearing date the day in the year of our Lord 1820
which said debt was incurred by them entirely for the benefit of the said
Henry Mish against which liability of said James Atgray the said
Henry Mish is desirous to secure him as well as all other moneys
which may be due and owing or may by any dealings
transfer of debts or papers or by any securities or any
liabilities of said James Atgray for the default of said Henry
Mish in any way become due or owing as also for and satisfaction
of the sum of one dollar is him in hand paid by the said
James Atgray as also for the further consideration of one other dollar
to him in hand paid by the said Merriweather P. Brannan and the
receipt whereof the said Henry Mish doth hereby acknowledge both grants
bargained and sold and by these persons doth grant bargain and sell
convey and make to the said Merriweather P. Brannan and his heirs
for ever all his right and interest in the following property (to wit)
one tract of land lying between the said James Atgray's land and the
about three and a half miles from Jerusalem containing 16 1/2 acres
as per Deeds one tract lying about one mile from Jerusalem on the road
to Mount Hermon containing 106 acres more or less the upper part building and so two sections
at Mount Hermon one house purchased of the heirs thereof
Kings Store together with all other property of any description whatever in
possession of or interest for the said Henry Mish. It is here and to have made
all the right and interest in said lands and other property herein
conveyed or intended to be conveyed to him the said Merriweather P.
Brannan his heirs and assigns from upon this special trust nevertheless
that the said Merriweather P. Brannan upon being thereto required by
the aforesaid James Atgray shall proceed to sell all the right
and interest of the said Henry Mish to the above named land
and other property hereby conveyed or intended to be conveyed after advertis-
ing the same and places in the said County of Hamp-
ton for ten days previous at some public place
