This Indenture made this 12th day of February One thousand eight
hundred and twenty one between David Nuson and Nathew his wife of the
County of Southampton of the one part and Benjamin Plumb Jr. of the
same County of the other part witnesseth that the said David Nuson
and his wife Martha for and in consideration of the sum of three hundred
and ninety dollars to them the said Nuson in hand paid by the said
Plumb the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged both parties bargained
and sold and by these presents as grant bargain and sell and confirm
unto the said Benjamin Plumb the hours and aysgs from thirty nine acres
of land lying in the County of Southampton and bounded as follows -
Beginning at a scrub oak a corner tree between David Nuson and
Benjamin Plumb in James Jackson's line thence South 28 M. 59 rods
to a Sycamore tree above the said road to the run of the Causeway branch
then up the said Branch to an ash a corner tree in said Branch thence
Plumb and Nuson line E. 8. C. from a post in a Hickory in Nuson's line thence
South E. 8. 6. 4. rods to the beginning To have and to hold the said tract
and parcel of Land with all and singular the premises and appurtenances
thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining unto him the said Benjamin
Plumb his heirs and assigns forever and the said David Nuson and his wife
Martha for themselves their heirs executors administrators and assigns doth covenant
and agree to and with the said Benjamin Plumb his heirs executors adminis-
trators and assigns to warrant and forever defend the title of the said premises
