This Indenture made this 12th day of February one thousand eight hundred and twenty one between David Norson and Martha his wife of the County of Southampton of the one part and Benjamin Whitm jr. of the same County of the other part Witnesseth that the said David Norson and his wife Martha for and in consideration of the sum of three hundred and ninety dollars to him the said Norson in hand paid by the said Whitm (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell and confirm unto the said Benjamin Whitm his heirs and assigns forever thirty nine acres of Land lying in the County of Southampton and bounded as follows - Beginning at a scrub oak corner tree between David Norson and Benjamin Whitm in James Jacksons line thence south 28 N. 59 poles to the selfsame oak corner tree the said road to the run of the causeway branch then up the said branch to an ash corner tree in said branch between Whitm and Norson then S. 3. E. 64 poles to a Hickory in Norsons line thence south 29 E. 64 poles to the beginning To have unto to hold the said tract and parcel of Land with all and singular the premises and appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining unto him the said Benjamin Whitm his heirs and assigns forever and the said David Norson and his wife Martha for themselves their heirs executors administrators and assigns doth covenant and agree to and with the said Benjamin Whitm his heirs executors administrators and assigns to warrant and forever defend the title of the said premises
