This Indenture made this 23rd day of February one thousand eight hundred and nineteen between Simon Peter Hill (free negro) of Sussex County and State of Virginia of the first part William Sudkins of Southampton of the second part and Gray S. Sudkins trustee chosen and appointed by the saids Peter Hill and William Sudkins of the third part Witnesseth that the saids Peter Hill stands fully indebted to the said William Sudkins the sum of two hundred dollars lawful money of the Commonwealth as well more fully appear by having reference to two bonds executed to the said William Sudkins by the saids Peter Hill bearing even date with this deed now to secure the said William Sudkins for the above sum and consideration of the sum of one dollar to him the saids Peter Hill in hand paid by the saids Gray Sudkins at or before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents as grant bargain and sold unto the said Gray S. Sudkins one certain tract or parcel of Land containing by estimation ninety two acres be the same more or less lying and being in the County of Southampton and State of Virginia and bounded by the lands of Broken Davis (free negro) between Peter Hill's other Land and William Sudkins it being the tract of Land which the saids Peter Hill -
