

This Indenture made this 1. day of March One thousand Eight
 Hundred and twenty between William Squire of the first part John
 Barnes Welling H. Barnes and Augustine Pope of the second
 part and Henry Foster of the third part and trustee to this
 deeds and all of the county of Southampton and state of
 Virginia. Witnesseth that whereas the said John Barnes
 Welling H. Barnes and Augustine Pope hath in several
 cases become bound as security for the said William Squire
 for debts due Paris Bryant in the sum of twenty nine dollars and
 Bonds due John Hargraves a Bond due Etheldreda Garman to the
 amount of thirty dollars for a sum due Evans Pope to the amount
 of twelve dollars also a Bond due the said Welling H. Barnes for
 twenty dollars a Bond due Drury Waller for the sum of one
 hundred and fifty dollars and a Bond due John Carter
 for the sum of thirty dollars. Now this Indenture further witnesseth
 that the said William Squire being willing and desirous of securing
 the said John Barnes, H. Barnes and Augustine Pope of the said
 securityships and also for and consideration of the sum of One
 dollar to him in hand paid by the said Henry Foster hath
 granted bargained and sold also by these presents doth grant
 bargain and sell unto the said Henry Foster and to his heirs and
 assigns forever one Gray Horse and certain tract or parcel of Land
 lying and being in the county of Southampton it being part
 of the lands whereon said Squire formerly lived and containing
 one hundred and forty acres more or less and bounded by the mile
 Runners line of Evans Pope John Barnes Welling H. Barnes and
 Augustine Pope also all the stocks of Cattle Hogs and Sheep belonging
 to said William Squire with all his household and Kitchen Furniture
 Plantation utensils of every species of property belonging to said William
 Squire to the said Henry Foster also his assigns forever and for the
 following intents uses and purposes VIZ he the said Henry Foster or his
 assigns may and shall at any time hereafter being requested by either
 of the parties sell at public sale for ready money all or so much of
 said property as shall be of sufficient value to pay and satisfy the
 amount of each of said debts and interest and expenses that may
 occur thereon in this case that said Henry Foster shall give ten
 days notice previous of the sale of the said property by public sale
 advertising the same in writing whereof each of the said parties have
 hereunto set their hands and seals the day and year above
