This Indenture made the twentieth of February in the year of our Lord
which one thousand eight hundred and twenty one between Samuel Torres
of the one part and Henry Leno of the other part all of the County of
Southampton parish of Williams and State of Virginia testifieth
that the said Samuel Torres for and in consideration of the sum of
twenty dollars current money of Virginia by the said Henry Leno
to of the said Samuel Torres in hand paid the receipt whereof the said
Samuel Torres doth fully acknowledge and forever acquit and discharge
the said Henry Leno his heirs executors and administrators and assigns
forever the said Samuel Torres has sold and transferred unto the said
persons doth grant bargain and sell all and singular his right title
and interest claim and demand whatsoever in a tract or parcel of land
containing by estimation ten acres in the same more or less lying and
being situate in the county and beginning at a Stake found
at a Branch a corner of Henry Leno's and Samuel Torres
line going from thence by a line off marked tree is a white oak
in the breast of a Branch next the Branch to the line found
thence to Henry Leno's line to the first station To Have and to Hold
to the said Henry Leno his heirs and assigns to the only proper use
and behoof of him the said Henry Leno his heirs and assigns forever
in as ample a manner as the said Samuel Torres would or could have done
in case this conveyance were had ^{made} been made and the said Samuel
Torres for himself his heirs the said land and every part thereof
against himself and his heirs and assigns and all and every other person
and persons whatsoever to the said Henry Leno does and shall and will
warrant and forever defend by these presents in writing whereof
the said Samuel Torres has hereunto set his hand and affixed
his seal this day and year first within written Inquis sealed and
