This Indenture made and entered into this 13<sup>th</sup> day of March in the  
year of our Lords One thousand eight hundred and twenty one between  
the said Fetes and Elizabeth his wife of the County of Southampton of the  
one part and William Fetes of the said County of the other part Witnesseth  
that whereas the said Frederick and Elizabeth his wife for and in consideration  
of the natural love and affection which they bear for their  
said son William Fetes as well for and in the further consideration  
of one dollar in hand paid in the receipt whereof we do hereby  
acknowledge have given granted bargained sold and conveyed and do by  
these presents give grant bargain sell make over transfer and convey  
unto the said William Fetes one certain tract or parcel of Land  
lying and being in the County of Southampton and bounded by the lands  
of the said Frederick Edward Herbert James Collins and John Davis and con-  
taining between sixty and seventy and be the same more or less being the  
said tract of Land conveyed by the said William Fetes to his father the said  
Frederick Fetes as he did record in the county Court of Southampton on the  
21<sup>st</sup> day of November 1820 reference being had the same well fully and at  
large appear and the said Frederick Fetes and wife for and in consideration  
of the promises aforesaid do further give grant convey sell over bargain  
unto the said William Fetes by these presents the following property to wit  
Two negroes namely Judy George Tom Mosley and wife together with  
the further increase also one gun and one pewee chest To have and to  
hold the said piece parcel or tract of Land with its appurtenances thereto  
belonging and personal Estate as aforesaid unto the said William Fetes  
his heirs and assigns to the only proper use and behoof of him the said  
William Fetes his heirs and assigns forever and the said Frederick Fetes  
for himself and wife his heirs executors and administrators do hereby covenant  
and agree to and with the said William Fetes and his heirs and assigns  
that he the said Frederick Fetes and his heirs the said tract or parcel of  
Land with its appurtenances as well the aforesaid two negroes slaves and  
their increase the said gun and chest unto him the said William Fetes  
his heirs and assigns against themselves the said Frederick and wife  
and against all and every person or persons whomsoever shall and do by these  
presents given granted and defined in witness whereof the said Frederick  
and wife have to these presents set their hands and affixed their seals  
the day and year first written
