This Indenture made this 21st of September one thousand eight hundred and eighth 1808 between James William Phillips and Laurence Cook Commissioners appointed by a decree of the County Court of Parrhampton to make sale of and convey the tract of Lands hereafter mentioned of the one part and Ethelred Edmunds of the said County of the other part Witnesseth that for and in consideration him of the sum of One Hundred and eighty dollars to the said James William Phillips and Laurence Cook in hand paid by the said Ethelred Edmunds the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained sold and by these presents do assign bargain and sell unto the said Ethelred Edmunds his heirs and assigns forever One certain tract or parcel of Lands lying and being in the County of Parrhampton and Parish of Saint Lukes and containing survey two Acs. It being the part assigned to the heirs of the late Col. Henry W. Edmunds of North Carolina in a division of the lands bequeathed by Samuel Edmund deceased to Sally Edmunds deceased being Lot 11th N. 1st beginning at a small pine standing on the side of the mill Pond a new corner made in Lot 11th N. 1st running thence S. 77. E. 19.2 poles to a small pine a new corner made in Lot 11th N. 1st at the out bounds thence South 20th N. 6.2 poles to a small pine in the old field near the orchard thence a new corner made in Lot 11th N. 1st and 5 thence S. 77th West 19.2 poles to a white oak a new corner made in Lot 11th N. 1st at the foot of the Crook may on the small pond side thence N. 45. E. 6.2 poles to the parish Station with all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining to them and to their heirs and assigns forever and the said James William Phillips and Laurence Cook Commissioners as aforesaid for themselves and their heirs the said tract or parcel of Lands with all and singular the premises and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said Ethelred Edmunds his heirs and assigns forever from the claim or claims of them the said Henry William Phillips and Laurence Cook or either of them their or either of their heirs shall well and do warrant and forever defend by these presents the making whereof
