Parker of the County of Winchester and State of Virginia of the other part Witnesseth that the said James Carr and Nancy Mc Carr wife for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars to them in hand paid before the executing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof they do hereby acknowledge to be their own free satisfaction and paid cash granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain sell alien set over and confirm unto him the said J. P. Parker all their right title and interest in and to a certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Southampton and State of Virginia and containing by estimation one hundred and fifty acres
