for and in consideration of the natural love and affection and of the sum of two hundred  
dollars to me in hand paid by Fanny Beal of the County of Southampton and Heir of  
North Carolina ab. or before the signing and delivery of these presents the receipt  
whereof I do hereby acknowledge and bargain, sell, grant and confirmed and by  
these presents do bargain, sell, grant and confirm to the said Fanny Beal a certain  
Negro Slave named Tom to have and to hold the said Negro Slave named Tom  
to the only proper use and behoof of the said Fanny Beal and her heirs forever and  
the said Thomas Tangham for myself and my heirs the said Negro Slave to the said  
Fanny Beal and her heirs against me the said Thomas Tangham and my heirs  
and against all and every person and persons whatsoever claiming by thing or under  
the said Thomas Tangham shall and well warrant and forth defend by these  
presents In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand affixed my seal this  
2<sup>nd</sup> day of November <sup>with the year</sup> 1821
