This Indenture made this twenty eighth day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty and <sup>to</sup> Edward Bragah Johnson of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the first part and James Brown of the same County and State of the second part and Sip Larkford of the same County and State of the third part Whereas the said James Brown has become security for the payment of a debt of two hundred and six dollars and twenty three cents which is due and owing from the said Bragah Johnson to Joshua ~~Johnson~~ of the said County as appears by a note executed to them the said Bragah Johnson and James Brown to the said Joshua ~~Johnson~~ for the sum aforesaid which note bears equal date with these presents and is made payable with interest from its date and whereas the said Bragah Johnson has also become security for a debt due and owing from the said Bragah Johnson to James Teste of the said County as appears by a note duly executed by the said Bragah Johnson and James Brown to the said James Teste for the sum of forty seven dollars which note also bears equal date with these presents and is made payable with interest from its date and whereas the said Bragah Johnson is willing and desirous to secure and save harmlessly him the said James Brown from any possible damage payment of money or any other inconvenience or trouble which might happen to him on account of these his securities or either of them Now therefore by the said Bragah Johnson for an consideration of the premises above mentioned but more especially for an consideration of one dollar he here un hands paid by the said Sip Larkford and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the said Bragah Johnson for himself his heirs etc ~~etc~~ shall grantee his aforesaid wife all and singular and by these presents with grantee bargains sell alien and confirm unto him the said Sip Larkford his heirs and assigns power all that mill Rums land or parcel of Land on which the said Bragah Johnson now resides and bounded as follows to wit Beginning at a sign a corner tree of Tolley Peals line or Black water run thence along a line of marked trees to a pine a corner tree of Benjamin Peals line thence along a line of marked trees to a rock a corner tree of William Bryant line thence down a certain branch a dividing line between his land and William Bryant to a maple and thence along a line of marked trees to the run of the trough Branch thence along the run of the said trough Branch to the river thence down the said river to the first stream
