 and confirm to the said Paulin Chittrey one certain parcel of property
 naming six heads of Cattle and three increased four heads of sheep and
 three increased two cows and five three sitting chairs one grubbing hoe
 one axe two pans and Flaming Tools and my present Crop of Sanguis corn
 Hadden Peas Golden Potatoes &c. to have and to hold the said property to the
 only proper use and in hope of the said Paulin Chittrey his heirs and
 assigns forever and I the said Dossan Chittrey for myself my heirs
 and administrators the said property named above to the said Paulin Chittrey
 his heirs and assigns against me the said Dossan Chittrey myself
 and assigns and against all and every other person or persons
 whatsoever shall and shall warrant and forever defend by these presents
 In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my
 seal this 16th August 1824.
