 Northampton and State of Virginia for and in consideration of natural love and
 affection and of the sum of three hundred dollars to me in hand paid by
 Henry J. Vaughan of the County of Northampton and State of North Carolina
 at or before the undersigned's special delivery for these presents the receipt whereof
 I do hereby acknowledge have bargained sold granted and confirmed and
 by these presents do bargain sell grant and confirm unto the said Henry
 J. Vaughan two certain negro slaves named Catharine and Easter to him
 and to hold to the said Henry J. Vaughan slaves named Catharine and Easter to
 the only proper use and behoof of of the said Henry J. Vaughan and his
 heirs forever. I the said Thomas Vaughan for myself and my heirs the
 said Henry J. Vaughan to the said Henry J. Vaughan and his heirs against one
 the said Thomas Vaughan and my heirs and against all and every person or
 persons whatsoever claiming by through or under them said Thomas shall and
 will warrant and defend by these presents In witness
 whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 2nd day
 of November in the year Eighteen hundred and twenty
 one

 This Indenture made this 19th day of March in the year of one thousand
 thousand eight hundred and twenty four between Abner Kinard and Elizabeth
 his wife of the County of Southampton of the one part and Samuel Harris of the
 same County of the other part Witnesseth that the said Abner Kinard and
 Elizabeth his wife for and in consideration of the sum of three hundred and
 eighty two dollars and twenty five cents to them in hand paid by the said
 Samuel Harris the receipt is hereby acknowledged have sold granted and
 confirmed and by these presents do sell grant and confirm to the said Samuel
 Harris one certain tract or parcel of land lying in the aforesaid County
 of Southampton containing by estimation twenty seven and one half acres and
 bounded beginning at a white oak on the side of Croffers road in the
 Northern line south thirty four degrees forty four poles then along said road in
 the east a corner in said tract Harris's line then along said line
 south thirty seven and a half degrees east to pole then south forty four
 degrees East thirty three poles to a lightness stump in the side of a branch
 then march sixty five degrees east thirty five poles to a large poplar in the
 said branch then south eighty degrees East fifty four poles then North eighty
