 that the said James Pomills in order to secure the payment of the sum of fifty five
 dollars and thirteen cents well interest this year from this day forth to be paid due
 Wm Jones (as per note of this day and for and satisfaction of one dollar
 to the said James Pomills in hand paid by the said William Jones at or
 before the making and delivery of these presents) the receipt whereof is hereafter
 recited) have granted bargained sold and he the said James Pomills hath
 granted bargained and sold by these presents unto the said Wm Jones his heirs and
 assigns a certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in Southampton County aforesaid
 adjoining the lands of James Collier John H. Chatman and others. Also containing
 one hundred and twenty five acres more or less the reversion and reversions remain-
 der and remainder hereof and other rents issues and profits thereof and every part
 and parcel thereof To Have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land with all
 and every of the appurtenances unto the said William Jones his heirs and
 assigns forever upon Trust nevertheless that the said William Jones shall
 as soon as he conveniently can after the 25th day of May next ensuing and after having
 advertised the time and place of sale of the land aforesaid at some publick place
 amongst the residences of the said James Pomills proceed to sell the same to the highest
 bidder for cash and out of the monies arising from such sale first pay and
 satisfy all reasonable charges attending the sale and then the debt above said
 and the residue of the money of any to him the said James Pomills his heirs and assigns
