This Indenture made this 19th day of February one thousand eight
 hundred and twenty one Between Benjamin Morrill and Nancy his wife
 of the one part and Mota Pope of the other part all of the County of Southampton
 and State of Virginia Witnesseth that the said Benjamin Morrill and Nancy
 his wife for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and twenty
 seven and five cents in hand paid by the said Mota Pope the receipt being
 hereby acknowledged with bargain and sale allured and off and con-
 veyed unto the said Mota Pope and to his heirs forever one certain
 Tract or parcel of Land lying in the County of Southampton aforesaid
 and in the Parish of Saint Peter containing by estimation of
 Twenty one & 1/2 acres of land lying lie the same more or less and
 bounded as follows to wit Beginning at a small pine a new
 Corner of Benjamin Morrill or George Williams line thence N.
 Fifty five and 1/2 degrees west thirty one poles to a small gum in
 said Williams line thence along said Williams line S. seventy five degrees
 N. 28 poles to a pine a corner of said Williams and John Nichols
 thence along said Nichols line S. seventy seven degrees N. twenty nine & 1/2
 poles to a stump corner of said M. Morris line N. fifty five & 1/2
 degrees N. 28 poles to a large pine in James Morrill's line in a
 small Branch thence along said Morrill's line N. thirty four degrees
 E. sixteen poles to a large pine thence North seventy six degrees E. twenty
 five poles to a small gum thence N. eighty four degrees E. twelve poles to
 on the Branch N. sixty two degrees E. twenty two poles to on the Branch
 thence South seventy nine & 1/2 degrees E. fourteen poles to on the Branch
 thence North fifty three & 1/2 degrees E. eighteen poles to on the
 Branch thence North seventy two and 1/2 degrees E. seven poles to a
 small maple in the said James Morrill's line thence along the said
 Benjamin Morrill's line S. seven degrees E. twenty four poles to the
 Beginning all the right title interest claims or demands of us and
 to the said tract of land of them the said Benjamin Morrill
 and Nancy his wife to have and to hold the said tract
 or parcel of land and premises with its appurtenances
