This Indenture made this twentieth day of October one thousand eight hundred and twenty by and between Edwin Croplin of Southampton County Virginia of the one part and Henry Gardner of the same County and State of the other part Witnesseth that whereas the said Edwin Croplin is indebted to Abraham Gardner guardian to Archer E. Gardner on four different notes executed by the said Edwin Croplin (to the said Abraham Gardner) guardian as aforesaid on the 29th day of December 1819 the first of which note is for the sum of thirty dollars payable on or before the 1st day of January 1831 the second for the like sum of 7-50 payable 1st January 1832 the third for the like sum payable on the 1st January 1833 and the fourth for the like sum of 7-50 payable 1st January 1834 To all which notes the said Henry Gardner is security and whereas the said Edwin Croplin is willing and desirous to indemnify and save harmless the said Henry Gardner for an account of his said security but more particularly for and in consideration of one dollar to him the said Edwin Croplin in hand paid by Thaddeus Vaughan at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents to the said Edwin Croplin hath granted bargained and sold unto by these presents with grant bargain sell and confirm unto him the said Thaddeus Vaughan and to his assigns forever its following personal property to wit one horse saddle and bridle one cart, wheel and gun shoes and furniture, one silver pan, one kettle, frying pan & tattle, sheet & chain square, stage, saws & mending bar, grubbing bar & plow bar & plow frame for traces all the cooking ware and all other house hold and kitchen furniture and plantation utensils not herein particularly enumerated which is now owned and possessed by him the said Edwin Croplin together with the property of 16 A. now standing on the plantation of present occupied by him the said Edwin Croplin and also every other corp benefice to be owned on the same plantation by the said Edwin Croplin for and during the term for which he has leased it.
