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This Indenture made this the twentieth day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty one between William of the first part Evans Pope of the second part and Augustus Pope of the third part and trustees to this deed all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia Writeth that whereas the said Evans Pope hath in severalty cast become indebted for the said William Supra first for a debt due Davis August in the sum of Twenty nine dollars a Bond due John Hargraves a Bond due E. Childers & Edmunds to the amount of thirty dollars for a Bond bearing date with these presents due Evans Pope to the amount of two hundred dollars also a Bond due Polling St. Barns for Twenty Dollars a bond due Priddy making for the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars and a Bond due John Barreto for the sum of thirty dollars Now this Indenture further Writeth that the said William Supra being willing and anxious for securing the said Evans Pope for said indebtedness and also for an insatisfaction of the sum of One dollar to him in hand paid by the said Augustus Pope hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Augustus Pope and to his heirs and assigns forever One certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Southampton & being part of the land whereon Anne Joseph formerly lived and containing One hundred and forty acres more or less and bounded by the mile Runn Rivers of Evans Pope Polling Barns and Augustus Pope and his heirs and assigns forever and for the following intents uses and purposes Viz he the said Augustus Pope for his heirs may and shall at any time hereafter being requested by either of the parties proceed to sell at Publick sale for ready money all or so much of said lands as will be of sufficient value to pay and satisfy the amount of each of said debts interest and expenses that may accrue thereon in this case that the said Augustus Pope shall give his day previous notice of the said land by publick advertisement of the same.
