 hereof is hereby acknowledged as well for the full sum consideration of the
 said Laurence Snipe being justly indebted to the aforesaid Thomas Patton
 in the full and true sum of five hundred and twenty three dollars and 26
 cents lawful money of Virginia which by the said Laurence Snipe is making
 more effectually be due to the said Thomas Patton and which is in fact
 the full object of these presents said grants bargains sold and confirmed and by
 these presents said grants bargains sold convey and confirm unto the said John
 Moore my next man Peter unto him the said John Moore his heirs Executors
 and administrators and upon their special trust and condition that the said
