affection which I bear to Robert Gray of the County and State above mentioned  
as well as for the further consideration of one dollar to me in hand paid by  
the said Robert Gray at or before the making and delivery of these presents  
the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have given and granted and by  
these presents do give grant unto the said Robert Gray his Executors, heirs  
and assigns one certain tract plantation and parcel of land lying and  
being situate in the County of Southampton adjoining the lands of Henry  
Briggs and containing by estimation four hundred acres the the same  
more or less and late the property of Joseph Gray deceased being that  
part of the Estate of Edmund Gray senior Decd. devised to the said Joseph  
Gray by the will of the said Edmund Gray senior Decd. and bounded  
as is expressed in the will of the said Edmund Gray senior Decd.  
which is of record in the County of Southampton reference being thereunto  
made more fully appears together with all Houses Orchards Gardens woods  
mazes ways rivers premises and all other profits and commodities thereto  
belonging or in any wise appertaining with the revenues and reversions  
rents profits and remainders with issues and profits thereof and every  
part and parcel thereof to have and to hold the said granted premises  
with the appurtenances unto the said Robert Gray his Executors administrators  
and assigns forever And the said Thomas Gray for himself his Executors  
the said tract a parcel of land with its appurtenances clear of all and free  
from all claim or claims or other incumbrances whatsoever unto the said Robert  
Gray his Executors administrators and assigns against the claim of him the said  
Thomas Gray his Executors and assigns and against the claim or claims of all and  
every Person or Persons whatsoever shall and will warrant and defend clear  
of these presents his heirs whomever he the said Thomas Gray ever hereunto set his  
hand and do seal on this 16<sup>th</sup> day of April and in the year of our said  
our thos and right honourable Sir my own Thomas Gray Esq.
